Energi, based in **Peabody**, is one of the top 10 fastest growing companies in MA, and specializes in providing risk management and insurance solutions to energy companies. Energi created 35 new jobs, and invested \$1.8M in its 42K SF space. www.energi.com



GE Healthcare Life Sciences, which sells bioreactors, diagnostic tools, and other gear for biotech drug manufacturing, consolidated two NJ sites to create the U.S. HQ in **Marlborough**, invested \$27M in a 210K SF space, and added 250 jobs. www.gehealthcare.com

Great Wolf Lodge is a resort and theme park which regained much of its popularity after renovating and adding its 40K SF waterpark in **Fitchburg**. The expansion investment totaled \$68.5M and helped to create 505 new jobs in the Gateway City. www.greatwolf.com



Framingham brewing company Jack's Abby began with three brothers who enjoyed making home-brewed beer. Now, the company has invested nearly \$6M in a 67K SF expansion and plans to have contributed to the revitalization of Framingham's downtown. www.jacksabby.com

The company expanded by 32K SF and increased its employee count by 35. Today, 10 percent of its workforce is comprised of disabled individuals which was part of its original mission.
