Notes on the
economy

According to **MassBio's August 2018 Industry Snapshot**, Massachusetts continues to experience a greater share of venture capital dollars, investments have reached all-time high, and job growth continues in the biotech industry. This success is expanding across the Commonwealth, with half of the 2017 Massachusetts-based IPOs occurring in outside of Cambridge in places like Waltham, Newton and Burlington.

In a report by **WalletHub**, measuring 25 aspects of education, **Massachusetts was ranked as having the best public school system in the country**. Massachusetts students had the highest test scores in reading and math and the fifth lowest rate of bullying. Read more [here](#).
