Expanding in MA

General Dynamics Corp. of **Pittsfield**, a leader in aviation, combat vehicles and electronic systems, has hired more than **100 employees** in 2011 to help work on a defense contract awarded by the Navy. More than 50% of the new employees have been hired from inside Berkshire County and another 25% from inside Massachusetts. CSX Transportation recently broke ground on a **\$100M** construction project in **Worcester**. The supplier of rail-based freight transportation is modernizing and expanding the existing intermodal terminal, expected to position Worcester as a major logistical hub for New England.
